

Purpose


The purpose of this document is to assist you to create a Bridge Base Online (BBO) username and to log on to enable you to participate in BBO activities.

Logging In

Log onto a computer and browser to the following website.


In the top right-hand corner of the screen, click the Login / Register button.



You will see something like the following.

If you have a BBO username enter your login and password and click the "Log In" button. You are done and will be taken to the BBO main screen.

If this is your first time, click the "Become a Member" button which will take you to the next screen.



Logging In For the First Time

Add details to the following screen, select a login name, a password, twice), an email address, your name, your American bridge number (enter as 0), a skill level and a country. Agree to the terms and conditions and Register.
